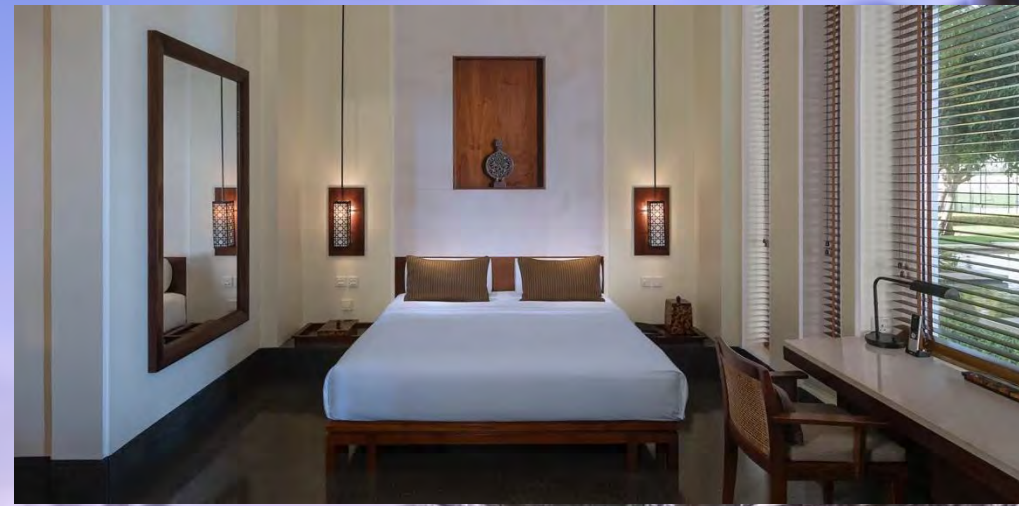

Tour Descriptions

Muscat

Day 1

Arrival.

Meet and greet with our team and transfer to the selected hotel

Day 2

Enjoy the diversity of the city in this full day tour. Visit the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque in the morning followed by an informative look around the Natural History Museum. Then drive out to the House of Amouage for a lesson in perfume production. Enjoy a picnic or lunch at a local restaurant before heading to Mutrah to see the vibrant Corniche and visit the Souq to browse and barter for some truly exquisite Omani souvenirs.

Spend the remainder of the afternoon in old Muscat visiting Bait al Zubair museum which is one of the most informative museums in Oman and focuses mainly on the traditional culture and lifestyle of the people of the Sultanate, Al Alam Palace and the old forts of Jalali and Mirani which guard it. Interestingly, these forts were built by the Portuguese in the 16th century.

Day 3

After collection from your hotel with luggage , we are on the road to Nizwa to visit the Fort and the Souq before stopping in town for a picnic or lunch at a local restaurant.

After lunch, an afternoon of stunning architecture lies ahead as you take in Bahla Fort, which was the oldest and first Omani fort to be built in the Islamic style, Jabreen Castle, probably the finest of Omanis castles built during the late 17th century and then head up to the traditional mountain village of Al Hamra to visit Bait al Safah living museum.

Day 5

Ibra is one of the oldest cities in Oman and was once a centre of trade, religion, education and art, famous for the fine horses and horsemen. The old quarter town still hides an evidence of the glory days, written in the remains of its stately mud brick mansions, numerous mosques and watchtowers. The ancient look of the city is what makes it so traditional, hence people say that in this city, time travelling is possible. A unique feature of Ibra is the 'Wednesday Souq' run entirely by women.

Shortly after passing Ibra, the gateway to the Sharqiya Region you have a chance for some natural retreats of Wadi Bani Khalid, where the water flows all year around in this beautiful and popular sight. A zigzag drive up the mountainside will get you to the entrance of this long river bed populated with villages and fertile plantations. The water flowing from several springs collects in deep, clear pools that are made easily accessible by a series of manmade paths and bridges. You may swim but remain respectful to the local people by staying well covered. As long as the water levels are not too high you can explore further into the undeveloped parts of the wadi and, not for the faint hearted, take some sturdy walking shoes and a torch and seek out the Moqal Cave.

Behind the petrol station in Al Wasil, the sand will open its stories on the way to mesmerizing Wahiba Sands. The Wahiba is a region of desert in Oman, named for the Bani Wahiba tribe, and is the perfect way to get a taste of the Arabian Desert fairy tales. Home to the Bedouins, the Sands offer a glimpse of a tradition that is fast disappearing as modern conveniences limit the need for a nomadic existence. You can ask the guide to take you for an experience of a light and short Dune Bashing, who will make sure this is in compliance with your own safety.

Day 6

From the desert, we head to SUR where you can walk around the old Dhow Yard watching the traditional craftsmen at work

After Sur we head up the coast ride Coast Road to see the aquamarine waters of the Bimmah Sinkhole before stopping at Al-Sharqiya White Sands, one of Oman's most stunning beaches.

We also have the option of a drive into Wadi Tiwi or a walk into Wadi Shab before continuing on to Muscat and the airport
